



Data Collection in Vietnam

As the project includes an applied example of a feasibility study for a biogas or biomass combustion plant at Phu Quoc island, it had been found necessary to collect data and see which sites are expected for the implementation.

Therefore a member of the Institute for Recycling and Environmental Protection (Bremen, Germany) went to Vietnam for a couple of days in November/December.

Additionally, important decision-makers of national, regional, districtional and local levels had been visited and informed about the project and its objectives. The reason was to ask for support and information needed for implementing a power plant for renewable energy in Vietnam. Furthermore it was helpful to hear about the plans to develop Phu Quoc towards a (green-)touristical future.
